Larry S. Bryant Multipurpose Center **Gym** to reopen Monday May 11, 2020

With Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson issuing a directive allowing gyms and fitness centers to resume activities on May 4, 2020 - if certain requirements are met, the City of Forrest City has taken steps to reopen the Larry S. Bryant Multipurpose Center Gym.

Forrest City Mayor, Cedric Williams is announcing that the Larry S. Bryant Multipurpose Center Gym will reopen Monday May 11, 2020. The hours of operation will be Monday – Friday from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. The pool will not be open.

The following requirements will be in place at the Multipurpose Center Gym:

- Screenings must be completed on everyone entering the building – staff members, and customers
- Daily temperature checks for employees and patrons
- 20 people at a time in the building
- Everyone must wear a mask, except while exercising
- Social Distancing of at least 12 feet while exercising
- All equipment must be wiped down after each use

No entrance will be granted to those who have:

- traveled and returned from New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, New Orleans, or overseas within the last 14 days
- a constant cough, sore throat, loss of taste or smell
- had contact with a person known to be infected with CIVID 19 within the previous 14 days
- have compromised immune systems and/or have chronic diseases.

**Basketball Courts and Baseball/Softball fields will remain closed. Outdoor walking track hours are extended to 6 pm at this location only.*
