

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
FORREST CITY CITY COUNCIL
FORREST CITY, ARKANSAS
February 19, 2019**

The City Council of Forrest City, Arkansas met in a Special Called Meeting on February 19, 2019. Mayor Williams called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. The following answered roll call: Mayor Williams, Clerk Cochran, and City Council members: Metcalf, Evansingston, Fields, Capps, Poteat, and Oswalt. Alderman Williams came in at 6:20 p.m. Also present were Representatives of ETC Engineers: Mizan Rahman, Shawkat Ali, and Will Andrews. Alderman Reeves and Attorney Wright were absent.

Mayor Williams stated the purpose of the meeting was to allow ETC Engineers' representatives to give an update on ongoing city projects. Handouts were given to the council for both projects to explain construction progress (See Attached Report). ETC engineer Mazan gave the council an overview of the new city hall and the aquatic center projects. He said the city hall project was 54% complete and the aquatic center project was 63% complete. The estimated completion date for the city hall project is June 25, 2019 and May 25, 2019 for the aquatic center project. Mazan discussed some change orders that were made to the city hall. He showed pictures of both projects. After his presentation, he fielded various questions from council members. The meeting was adjourned at 6:05pm.
